


SENIOR FEES

As we race towards graduation, we want to remind our Class of 2025 families that the \$150 senior fee must be paid in order for students to receive their cap and gown. If you've already taken care of this, thank you! If not, please submit payment at your earliest convenience.



Frequent early pickups and missed class time can add up quickly! School is still in session until the final bell, and students need to be present to meet the state's required seat hours for credit. Unless it's an emergency, please plan for students to remain in class through the full school day to support their learning and academic success.



BBCA Summer Camp Registration Is Now Open!

Get ready for a summer full of adventure, fun, and faith at BBCA's Yeehaw Summer Camp! Designed for children ages 3-12, our camp offers an exciting and engaging environment where kids can learn, play, and grow. Camp runs from 7:30 am to 6:00 pm, providing a full day of activities, games, and hands-on learning—all while enjoying a faith-based atmosphere.

Closed enrollment is now open, giving current families the first opportunity to secure a spot before registration opens to the public on April 28.

With limited availability, we encourage BBCA families to take advantage of this closed enrollment period to ensure their child doesn't miss out.

The registration fee is \$75 per child, and the weekly camp tuition is \$150 per child. Daily meals are included, with breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack provided.
